#### **NEW ITEM**

Miracle-Gro All Purpose Plant Food (NPK 24:8:16): 1kg + 20% £4.85

#### **KNOW YOUR FERTILIZERS**

**Nitrate of Chalk/nitrochalk (27:0:0):** Quick-acting, growth-promoting nitrogen fertilizer in granular form. Contains some lime, so use to reduce acidity. Particularly good for brassicas and root vegetables. Avoid acid-loving plants. Use April to September. Top dressing 1 oz/sq yd. **Our price 3kg for £2.70.** 

Multicote 6 (15:7:15 + magnesium and trace elements): A controlled release fertilizer for bedding plants and containers. Provides a continuous supply of nutrients over a 6 month period. Our price 1kg for £3.90.

Don't forget to bring something for our produce stall at the show. On the produce stall we sell plants and any other excess garden produce you may have e.g. rhubarb. Jams, marmalade & chutneys are also welcome. The money raised helps cover the cost of hiring the hall.

### **TOP 10 JOBS TO DO IN JUNE**

For further information go to www.rhs.org.uk/advice

- 1. Hoe borders regularly to keep down weeds
- 2. Be water-wise, especially in drought-affected areas
- 3. Pinch out sideshoots on tomatoes
- 4. Harvest lettuce, radish, other salads and early potatoes
- 5. Position summer hanging baskets and containers outside
- 6. Mow lawns at least once a week
- 7. Plant out summer bedding
- 8. Stake tall or floppy plants
- 9. Prune many spring-flowering shrubs
- 10. Shade greenhouses to keep them cool and prevent scorch
