

Sandhurst Gardening Club – Seed Orders 2020

As we enter the autumn it is now time to consider your seed orders for next year. Many of you who have ordered seeds in the past will know that we are able to generate discounts based on the volume of seeds we order collectively as a club. In previous years this has been 60% on seeds, a significant saving. We will again be using Mr Fothergill's who offer this discount if our seed order exceeds £1000.

Mr Fothergill's seed catalogues will be available from the Trading Hut from this **Sunday** (4th October).

An order form will be inserted in the catalogue, each order will incur a charge of £1.95 which is for your seeds to be individually packed. Please use this form for your order. Additional forms can be collected from the trading hut for large orders (more than 30 seed varieties) but please attach together when you return. Can I ask that in completing your order you ensure that it is legible as it will ensure that you receive what you ordered. Please return the white and blue pages and retain the green page for your records. Orders must be returned by the **15th November at the latest. I cannot accept any orders after this date.**

For clarification **seed orders only relate to packeted seeds. Seed orders do not include seed potatoes, onions shallots, fertilisers, garden sundries, etc** which do not attract the same discounts (maximum of 15%, but typically 10%). Mr Fothergill's include these in their seed catalogue. These items can be ordered but will incur an additional order charge of £4.95 and please select **delivered to your home address**. Also from past experience as the order is not submitted until late November autumn planting products listed in the catalogue will not be available so please do not consider these in your order.

I will not be completing a separate order with JBA for potatoes this year.

Bulbs are selling well but there is still a good selection available at the hut. All are displayed outside the hut for you to see the pictures. The best deal are Camelot, an award winning upright all golden yellow daffodil with some fragrance. At £8.70 for 7kg or only £1 for 10 they must be the cheapest you can buy.
